

TOWN OF CEDAR FORT BURN POLICY

ADOPTED AUGUST 25, 2009

I) AGRICULTURAL BURN POLICY (2 acre plot or larger and irrigation ditches)

No open or outside agricultural burning of any kind is allowed within the town limits of Cedar Fort unless:

- A. A burn permit is issued by the fire department. The permit fee is \$20.00 and is issued each spring (lapses each spring on March 1 regardless when it was issued the previous year).
- B. The items being burned are not manufactured items.
- C. Burning is done only during daylight hours between the time of one-half hour before sunrise and one-half hour after sunset.
- D. There is no appreciable wind.
- E. Such burning is not done closer than twenty-five (25) feet from buildings, structures, or other combustible material.
- F. There is at least one adult person in actual attendance with water, garden hose, shovels or other fire extinguishing equipment on hand and who is in charge of such fire at all times during its burning.
- G. The fire is not for any commercial or industrial purpose or use.

Note: Call (801) 374-BURN to determine whether it is a legal burn day. Notify the county of when you are burning (leave a message if a person does not answer).

II) OPEN BURN POLICY (Any plot size)

No open or outside general burning of any kind is allowed within the town limits of Cedar Fort unless:

- A. A burn permit is issued by the fire department. The permit fee is \$5.00 and is issued each spring for a two week period as determined and posted by the fire department with at least 2 week's notice prior to the burn period.
- B. The items being burned are not manufactured items.
- C. Burning is done only during daylight hours between the time of one-half hour before sunrise and one-half hour after sunset.
- D. There is no appreciable wind.
- E. Such burning is not done closer than twenty-five (25) feet from buildings, structures, or other combustible material.
- F. There is at least one adult person in actual attendance with water, garden hose, shovels or other fire extinguishing equipment on hand and who is in charge of such fire at all times during its burning.
- G. The fire is not for any commercial or industrial purpose or use.

Note: Call (801) 374-BURN to determine whether it is a legal burn day. Notify the county of when you are burning (leave a message if a person does not answer).

III) RECREATIONAL BURN POLICY (Any plot size)

No open or outside recreational burning of any kind is allowed within the town limits of Cedar Fort unless:

- A. Such burning is not done closer than twenty-five (25) feet from buildings, structures, or other combustible material. Fires (flames) taller than (2) feet are considered a recreational bon fire. A recreational bon fire requires a minimum of (50) feet from buildings, structures, or other combustible material.
- B. The fire is a maximum diameter of (3) feet and flame of 2 feet tall.
- C. The fire should be completely out before being abandoned.
- D. The items being burned are not manufactured items.
- E. There is at least one person in actual attendance with water, garden hose, shovels or other fire extinguishing equipment on hand and who is in charge of such fire at all times during its burning.
- F. There is no appreciable wind.
- G. The fire is not for any commercial or industrial purpose or use.

Note: Recreational fires do not require a burn permit or a green burn day.
